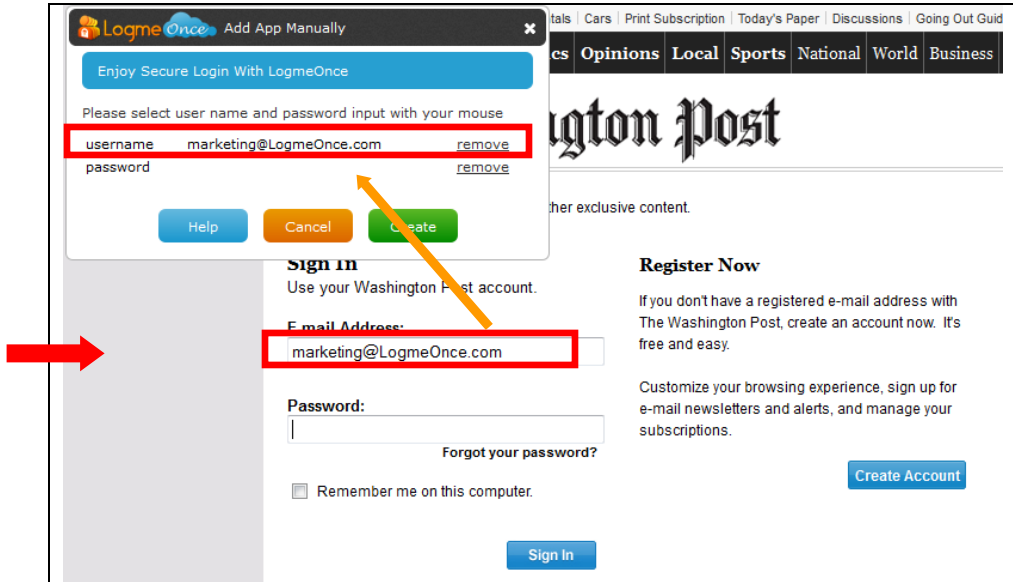


Now, Click on LogmeOnce extension menu, and from pull down menu, select “Add App Manually”.

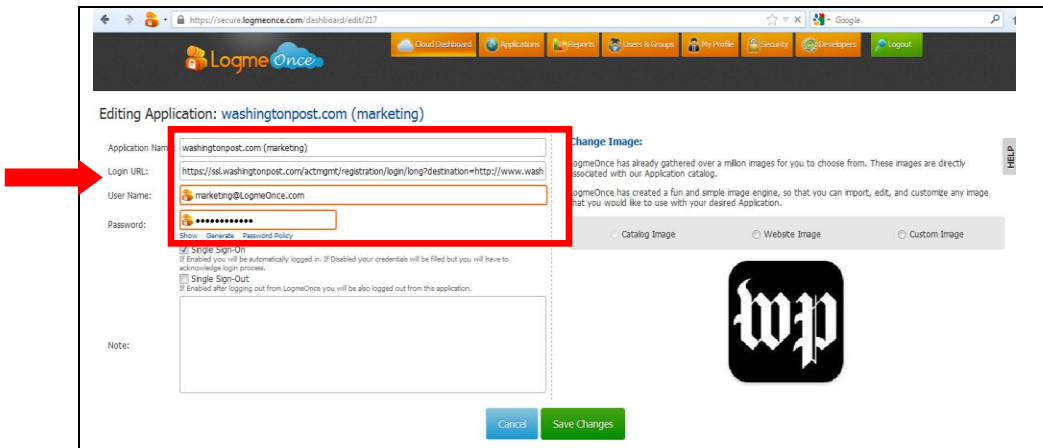


A LogmeOnce dialog box will appear.
